

WHAT IS COMHAIRLE NA NÓG?



Comhairle na nÓg are youth councils which are based in 31 local authority areas in the country. They give young people and children the opportunity to be involved in the development of local services and policies that affect them. Our members then try to influence local decision makers to achieve their desired outcome, impact or change.

WHO ARE WE?

We are Galway County Comhairle na nÓg and we represent young people aged 12 – 17 years of age from all over County Galway. We are from all from different part of the County as well as different backgrounds, cultures and ethnicities. We meet at least once a month, usually on a Saturday and work on our chosen topic, as voted on by you during our Annual General Meeting.

To give you a taste of what topics we have previously worked on: Challenging Prejudice, Climate Change, and this year, we have been working on the topic of Mental Health & Wellbeing.

All children and young people have a right to be heard in all matters affecting them. If you feel like your voice is not being heard, or you would like to be part of something that values what you have to say, then this is the group for you.
